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


cupcakes. DEEEE-LICIOUS!

across the kitchen floor.







Dancing reminds me of my new ballerina stickers, so I gracefully skip and twirl to my art corner.

Sticker art is my favorite. I put stickers on **EVERYTHING...**




I have a new thought. Maybe I'll be an animal doctor.


But instead of treating regular animals, I'll be a

specializing in baby dragons, fluffy monsters, and unicorns!












I'm completely exhausted and out of time. I still have no idea what to do! There are so many things I enjoy, so how can I choose just one?




